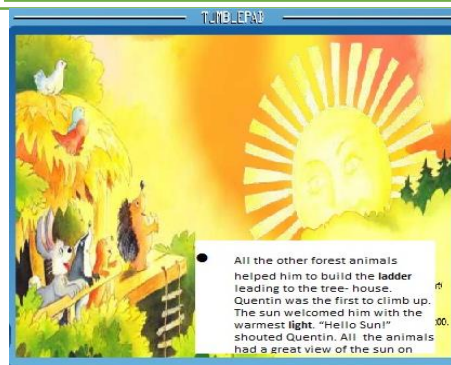
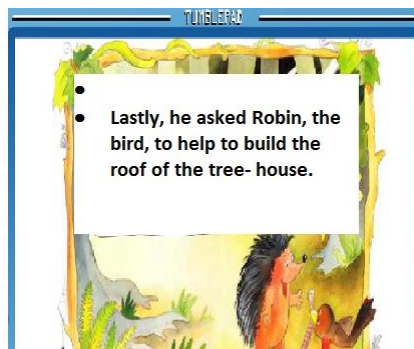
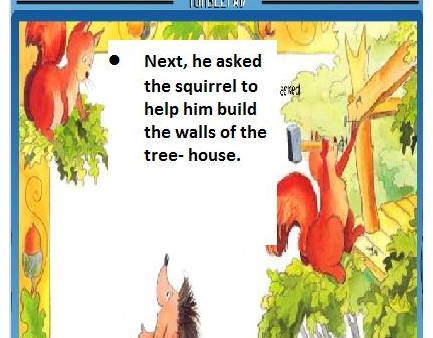
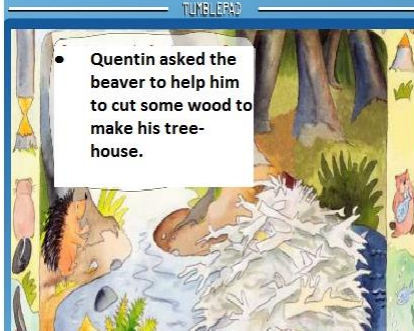
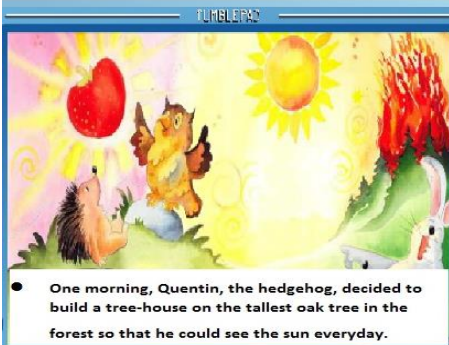
# **FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITIES FOR PARENTAL USE**

# Features of a Narrative Story

## ~Beginning~

Setting:

-where & when did the story take place?

- who were the main characters in the story?

(where/ when/ who)

## ~Middle~

Development:

-What happened in the story?

-What is the sequence of events?

(what)

## ~Problem~

Is there any problem in the story?

(what/ why)

## ~Solution~

Is there any solution in the story?

(why/ how)

## ~End~

- How did the story end?

- Is there a climax in the story?

- How did the characters feel in the end?

(how)
